- (5) To be free to attend religious services or activities of his/her choice and to have visits from the spiritual advisor of his/her choice. Attendance at religious services, either in or outside the facility, shall be on a completely voluntary basis. In Child Care Centers, decisions concerning attendance at religious services or visits from spiritual advisors shall be made by the parent(s), or guardian(s) of the child.

- Lead poisoning can harm a child's nervous system and brain when they are still forming, causing learning and behavior problems that may last
- Lead can lead to a low blood count (anemia).
- Even small amounts of lead in the body can make it hard for children to learn, pay attention, and succeed in schoo
- can damage the nervous system, kidneys, and other major organs. Very high exposure can lead to Higher amounts of lead exposure selzures or death

### **LEAD POISONING FACTS**

- Buildup of lead in the body is referred to as lead poisoning.
- Lead is a naturally occurring metal that has been used in many products and is harmful to the human body. There is no known safe level of lead
- in the body.
- Small amounts of lead in the body can cause lifelong learning and behavior problems.
- Lead poisoning is one of the most common environmental illnesses
- California children.
  The United States has taken many steps to remove sources of lead, but lead is still around us.

- Lead in house paint was severely reduced in 1978.
- Lead solder in food cans was banned in the 1980s.
- Lead in gasoline was removed in the early 1990s.



#### LEAD IN TAP WATER

The only way to know if tap water has lead is to have it tested.





Tap water is more likely to have lead if:

- fixtures, solder (used for joinin metals), or service lines have lead in them. Plumbing materials, including joining
- Water does not come from a public water system (e.g., a private well),

To reduce any potential exposure to lead in tap water:

- Let water run at least 30 seconds before using it for seconds pefore using it for cooking, dinking, or baby formula (if used). If water has not been used for 6 hours or longer, let water run until it feels cold (1 to 5 minutes.)\* Flush the pipes in your home
- Use only cold tap water for cooking, drinking, or baby formula (if used) if water needs to be heated, use cold water and heat on stove or
- Care for your plumbing
  Lead solder should not be used

  water for 3-5 minutes.\*

A blood lead test is free if you have Medi-Cal or if you are in the Child Health and Disability Prevention Program (CHDP). Children on Medi-Cal, CHDP, Children on Medi-Cal, CHDP, Head Start, WIC, or at risk for lead poisoning, should be tested at age 1 and 2. Health insurance plans also will pay for this test. Ask your child's doctor about those lead so the start of blood lead testing.
