




Meet Gilbert!

During the month of April, we will continue to explore new life and life-cycles. Spring is rife with opportunities to go on walks and listen for baby birds, search for bugs, and notice the blooming flowers!

We will be exploring the process of metamorphosis in caterpillars and tad poles, as well as discovering how plants grow. This is such a wonder-filled month as we witness these precious miracles that God has given us!

This month is going to be a fun filled science month. We will be talking about Jesus' resurrection, butterflies and gardening. We will watch real butterflies go through their life cycle, and strengthen our counting skills with counting peas. Vegetables and fruits will also be explored through painting and sorting. The letters that we will be focusing on are T, U and V. This month we will be taking a closer look at the color purple and the oval shape.

We will be celebrating Easter on April 1st (M-W-F class) and April 2nd (T-Th class). Before our celebration we will be dyeing and counting eggs. During our celebration we will also have an Easter egg hunt in the classroom.

Spring is here! Our April curriculum is "Sunshine and Snowflakes". The purpose of this unit is for the students to learn more about the four seasons. The children will talk about each season and the clothing, food and weather that go along with each. They will also create a "Four Seasons" book that can be shared with families at home. We also will be talking about the Good News! I will use the Resurrection Eggs to help the children understand the true meaning of Easter, the death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus Christ.
