We will begin the month celebrating Dr. Seuss & Lutheran School's Week. This is a very fun week which will include dressing up like a Dr. Seuss Character, and crazy hair day! This unit is chock full of amazing literature, that incorporates beginning sounds, rhymes, and nonsense words... all of which makes it so fun! It's all about phonemic awareness...helping children make sense of letters and sounds, which is so important for pre-readers. Furthermore, as spring approaches, we will move into our Farm unit as we explore and learn about growing crops, observe how baby farm animals and chicks grow and develop, along with the symbolism and importance of eggs. This exposure to new life leads us directly into the Easter Story toward the end of March, where we will learn about and celebrate the resurrection of Jesus!
