A NOTE FROM YOUR TEACHERS

Mrs. Hardison: March has literally zoomed by as we began our explorations of eggs, chicks, new life, and Easter! We have been busy predicting what we think will happen next in the stories we're reading, as well as in our science experiments. We have also been recording our observations (we learned that this means we watch and see what happens) by graphing and 'writing' in our journals. The children and I have thoroughly enjoyed this meaningful and intentional way of learning! During the month of April, we will continue to explore new life and life-cycles, especially among insects and amphibians, where the process of metamorphosis opens a brand new series of questions and explorations for the children to learn from. This is such a wonder-filled month as we witness these precious miracles that God has given us!

Mrs. Yeakel: Happy Spring Room 8! What a fun month April brings us-the season has officially come into full bloom with Spring and we will embrace every moment! We will have a wonderful time exploring the world of Spring with discussions on our bug critter friends, seeds, growth and more! Speaking of growth, I love hearing each of the students Book Reports-if you need a new report sheet for what ever reason please let me know! In addition to our talks on Spring, we will be continuing our conversations on community helpers. Please be on the look out for information from our room parents as they are working with Cal-Fire to set up a family field trip! Also mark your calendars as we will have a yellow day on April 28th. Mrs. Micallef: Pre K April Theme: Let's Go! This month we will focus our attention on different modes of transportation, discussing the many different ways in which people move from place to place. We will explore planes, trains, cars, buses and more, as well as learn about many kinds of specialty vehicles that help transport people and things. We will also take some time to focus on our "Waste Management" system and the concept of "Recycling" and why this is so beneficial to our planet Earth.

Encourage your child to share with you what our class is learning about recycling and transportation; as you ride or walk from place to place with your child, encourage discussion about the vehicles around you. This also provides an opportunity to play counting games amongst other games that help develop observation skills. For example, you might ask your child to count the number of red cars they see; you may choose a type of vehicle, such as a truck, and have your child count the number of trucks s/he sees. On long rides, you may want to provide paper and pencil and encourage your child to keep count of vehicles s/he sees by making tally marks.
