A Note from our Teachers:

Mrs. Hardison: Welcome to preschool! This is such an exciting time for you and your child here at OSLS. During the year the children will have so many opportunities to learn new skills, as well as strengthen those skills they already have. This is a time for growth and exploration, for learning social skills and making friends, and I feel so blessed to be a part of this special time in your child's life! Each day begins with circle time, where we read, sing songs, learn finger plays, do a daily calendar and explain our activities for the day. **This is a vital part of our day, so please arrive on time each day.** School starts at 8:45 right after our morning gathering outside. Your child will also have the opportunity to explore art and science activities, use manipulatives for fine motor development, explore concepts of print and writing skills, engage in hands-on math, as well as free choice activities such as dramatic play, blocks, books and puzzles. Large motor skills will be developed during our outdoor activities as well. During this first month of school we will be getting to know each other, learning classroom rules, and our daily routine, along with concepts such as colors, shapes and sizes. The preschoolers will be sharing about what makes them special, along with their family, home, and pets. This is a fun and engaging month that helps us all get to know each other.

Mrs. Micallef: Welcome back to school; I am very excited to begin our 2016-17 school journey with all my students and families! We will begin our Transitional Kindergarten program by focusing on each and every one of the students and their families! Our September theme, "I'm Special!" will offer us the opportunity to think about and explore the things that make them unique and special. During the early years children begin to develop a sense of self – of their special and separate identities. They develop their own interests, and they learn that language is an important tool for expressing those interests. We will listen to selections and engage in activities that focus on what makes each and every one special. Simultaneously we will learn that, in spite of differences, people are the same in many ways. We will also learn about our families; each student will have an opportunity to create a small poster highlighting their family, which they will share with the whole class! We are on to an amazing journey and cannot wait to get started! Fasten your seatbelts and let us all enjoy the ride together!
