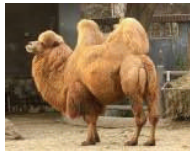

Educational Field Trips

Our 2nd graders will meet "Big Al" fish at the Dana Point Ocean Institute on 4/21 as he searches for friends. They will interact with interesting ocean creatures while conducting investigations in underwater adaptations, camouflage and different types of habitats.



The third grade class will be visiting the San Diego Zoo to prepare for their endangered species project. While visiting they will preview the habitats of many endangered species of animals while observing the animals. The tour guide will discuss conservation issues as well. One of the highlights of the trip is going behind the scenes and meeting several animals, e.g. Bactrian camel and the giraffe.
