

Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) is a computerized, adaptive test which helps teachers, parents and administrators improve learning for all students and make informed decisions to promote a child's academic growth. Second through Fifth grades will testing during the month of May. This test replaces the Stanford Achievement Test, that was previously used.
