Order forms and details go home today in the blue communication folders. Candy sales begin immediately and run through Nov. 30th. Order forms are due no later than December 1st.

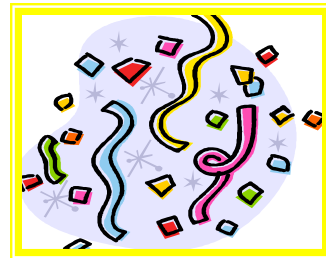

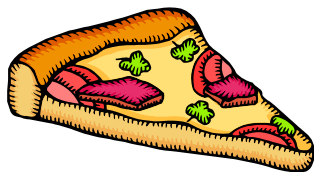

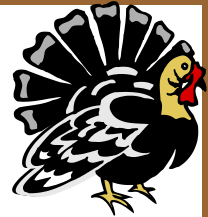
